GAME OUTLOOK

Wheaton Academy will open up their 2006 IHSA Regional play Monday night at Geneva High School against Kaneland High School from Maple Park. The Kaneland Knights come into the game with an overall record of 14-12, but have caught fire in the tail end of their season, winning their last six straight games. Last Friday night the Knights defeated Glenbard South in overtime. Third year head coach Brian Rea leads a disciplined basketball program in all aspects of the game. The team is led in scoring by 5'11" point guard Brad Harner who averages 15.7 points per game as well as 4.5 rebounds per game. Kaneland is a team that moves the ball very well offensively, and prides themselves in their frequently-changing defenses.

Head Coach Andy Euler's Warriors, who started the season 0-5, but have progressed up to a record of 16-11 after winning the last 16 of 22 games look to advance to the regional semi-finals with a win over Kaneland Monday night. WA comes into the game with a four-game winning streak, including a 53-44 comeback victory at home against Chicago Christian as well as a 57-46 win over Montini last Wednesday. The team is led by seniors Jeremy Parker and John Tillery who are averaging 13.3 and 10.8 points per game respectively. The defining element to the Warriors' success this season has been their defensive intensity and aggressiveness, and that will be the case Monday night in addition to the ability of hitting a high percentage of their shots.
