GAME OUTLOOK

Wheaton Academy comes off of a tough 51-43 loss to Prospect to face the number 3 ranked in the state of Illinois St. Joseph Chargers of Westchester, Illinois. The Chargers defeated St. Charles East on Wednesday night, their second win of the season 70-43. The Warriors faced St. Joseph last year and played them to a 76-61 loss. Jeremy Parker led the team last year with 20 points in the loss.

LAST YEAR AGAINST ST. JOSEPH [Daily Herald]

With a break in the action and 3:49 remaining in the first quarter of the game between Wheaton Academy and highly rated St. Joseph, not a lot of people were surprised to see the score was 16-4.

The surprise was that it was the Warriors with the early lead Friday at the 46th annual St. Charles East Thanksgiving Invitational.

Junior guard Jeremy Parker came out firing with 14 first-quarter points, including four 3-pointers. The Chargers were able to end the quarter on a 11-3 run to make it a 19-15 Warriors lead at the end of one period of play.

"It's nice to shoot well," said Warriors coach Andy Euler. "I was pleased with our discipline. We pushed the ball like we wanted to yet we ran our passing game very well."

St. Joseph opened the second half with a 10-0 run to give the Chargers a 43-35. After the Warriors closed the third quarter with a 3-pointer from Matt Almaraz and a nice driving layup from John Tillery, St. Joe led 51-46.

The Chargers had another run of 15-3 in the fourth quarter to put them up 67-52 with 4:11 remaining. St. Joe (3-0) was led by junior guard Jonathon Peoples with 14 second-half points and a game-high 21.

"You have to give them a lot of credit," said St. Joseph coach Gene Pingatore. "They pushed us to the limit. They played very hard, they were mentally tough and did what they wanted to do."

Parker was limited to 3 points in the second half to wind up with a team-high 20 for the game. Almaraz picked up his scoring in the second half with 8 to finish with 10. Jason VanderVeen and Axel Cerny had 8 points each with VanderVeen playing solid defense against St. Joe standout Tony Freeman, limiting him to 5 second-half points.
